


## **Please Note:**

- All tents must be placed only on the designated 16' x 16' tent pad.
- · Pets must be kept on a leash no longer than 6' and must not be left unattended.
- · Black water and gray water can only be discharged at the dump station
- · Keep camp and picnic areas clean.
- · All vehicles must remain on the pavement.
- Campsite CHECK OUT time is 2 pm. Renewal requests should be made by 9 a.m. and are subject to site availability.
- · Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. and guests who do not have a camping permit must leave the park by 10 pm.
